The *FATE Master Educator Award* and a *FATE Emerging Educator Award* will be presented in conjunction with the FATE Biennial Conference in Portland, Oregon, April 1 – 4, 2009.

Criteria

- *Dedication to Foundations teaching and/or administration, capacity for innovation, willingness to share knowledge, and contribution to FATE as an organization.*
- *Any member can submit nominations (additional nomination forms are available on the FATE website)*
- *FATE Master Educator - active in organization for at least 10 years, major commitment and contribution.*
- *FATE Emerging Educator - active for less than ten years, evidence of strong commitment and increasing contribution. Graduate students may also be nominated in this category.*

Guidelines

A. Nominations

1. Any member of the FATE organization may nominate candidates for the *FATE Master Educator* or *FATE Emerging Educator*.
2. Nominations must be supported by a letter of recommendation. Letters should address, but are not limited to the following:
 - a) Dedication to foundations teaching and/or administration
 - b) Capacity for innovation
 - c) Willingness to share knowledge
 - d) Contribution to FATE as an organization
3. Completion of the *FATE Master Educator form (form A)*; or *FATE Emerging Educator form (form B)*.
4. All nomination materials must be received by the FATE Award Committee Chair by **May 1, 2008**.

B. Selection

1. The letters of recommendation will be reviewed by the FATE Award Committee and Chair of the Award Committee. The President of FATE may be consulted, if necessary, to provide relevant expertise and guidance.
2. Upon request by the committee, nominees will provide (1) an up-to-date vita for review; and (2) a one-page summary of his or her dedication to foundations teaching and/or contribution to FATE (optional).
3. The committee reserves the right not to make an award, if in its judgment, no recommendations submitted meets the selection criteria as stated above (section A-2).

C. Award

1. Recognition of the *FATE Master Educator* and *FATE Emerging Educator* will be made during the FATE Biennial Conference in Portland, Oregon.
2. Introduction of the award recipients and presentation of a \$250 check for each award will be held at a special reception.

The *FATE Master Educator Award* and a *FATE Emerging Educator Award* is supported by an anonymous donor who was motivated by the recent and untimely death of Jeff Link, Vice President of Communications for FATE (Columbus College of Art and Design). The donor made the observation that FATE should have an achievement award to recognize major contributors in the field.
